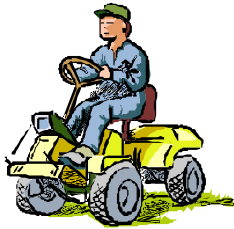
## **From the President of the Board of Directors...Brady Terrell**

## **From your Course Superintendent...Butch Howard**

**We have had a reasonably mild winter, though wind and ice have taken its toll! I would have liked to have seen a significant snow to insulate the turf and to give the course a rest. We have had an inordinate amount of work cleaning up downed trees and limbs; we also used some of the milder days to remove several trees to improve playing conditions. We have also been able to paint the**

**ladies lounge, areas of the ballroom, and some touch up where needed.**

**In preparation for the 2008 golf season we will be making modifications to the left back of hole #1 reducing the fall off that currently exists. We will be aerifying and top dressing the tees April 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>; greens and fairways will be aerified April 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, please plan your golf accordingly.**

**We will be opening hole #10 for play mid April so that it is available for opening day. Winter tees are still in place; summer tees will be used in early April. Please remember that maintenance staff are on the course doing work that enhances your golfing experience. We try to minimize impact on play but your patience and understanding is requested. For the early bird golfers you need to be particularly cognizant of the maintenance staff. In order to prepare the course for the day the greens need to be cut, you need to wait for mowing to be completed on the green before completing the hole. Please be patient and allow maintenance staff to complete their work!**

## **From your PGA Professional...Mark Wiley**

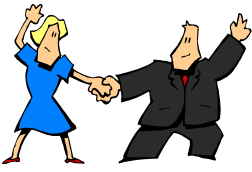

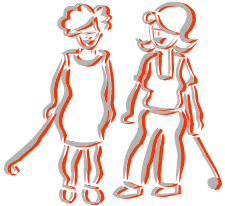

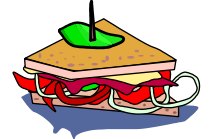

Please note that the deadline for students to apply for the Bon Air Scholarship is June 1. Applications are available online or through the Pro Shop.

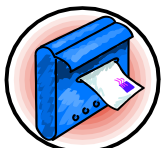

**Cart Rules - Revisited**

The purpose of the cart rules pertaining to the cart paths and routes is to preserve the playing surface of the course. On all of the par 3's carts should remain on the cart path. If you hit your drive sideways, leave your cart on the cart path and walk to your ball. Do not drive off the cart path to another fairway.

On Holes 3, 5,7,9,10,11,12,13,15,17, and 18 cart paths are on one side of the green. Carts should be driven to that side of the green. Carts should not go on the opposite side of the green even though your ball is there. Park your cart on the path and walk over to your ball. No carts should be closer than 30 feet to the green (15 feet for cart operators with certified disabilities). A good rule of thumb is when there is a paved cart path keep the cart on the cart path. For those with handicap flags you must keep your cart on par 3 cart paths except hole #8, where the cart may be driven to the back of the green but no closer than 15 feet of the fringe of the putting surface....**DO NOT DRIVE UP THE FRONT OF THE GREEN!**

***BACC Dress Code***

- ◆ Proper golf attire is required at all times and applies to everyone using any of the golf facilities, and includes the driving range and practice putting greens!
- ◆ Men's Dress Code: shirts with collars and sleeves with shirt tails tucked into slacks or shorts, slacks and golf shorts (not more than 4 inches above the knee).
- ◆ Ladies Dress Code: Dresses, shirts, slacks, skirts and golf shorts (not more than 4 inches above the knee).
- ◆ Jeans are not permitted at any time.
- ◆ Shoes must be worn at all times. Golf shoes with soft spikes are required; tennis shoes and soft-shoes are permitted.



Everyone, as in everyone, must sign-in in the GolfShop prior to going onto the course. This applies whether you are walking or riding. If you are unsure about how to sign-in ask for assistance from GolfShop staff.



A quick review of rules covering Children Under Twelve (12) Years of Age. Note - Detailed explanations are included in the BACC Club Rules Document.

- A son or daughter of a member under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied by an adult member at all times and will have the following privileges:
- Monday through Friday (excluding Holidays) may use the club facilities at any time only when accompanied by an adult member.
- Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays They may use the club facilities after 5 PM and then only when accompanied by an adult member.
