PURPOSE OF JUNIOR GOLF

The focus is to help our children learn and improve both skills and rules of golf. Our goal is to provide a solid fundamental base from which to play and to instill the courtesies of the game so that our players can enjoy golf for a lifetime. While learning and improving we want each child to understand and practice proper golf etiquette.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What group should my child be in?

Experience, stamina and enthusiasm can be judged best by the parents to determine which group best suits your child. After the golf camp any changes as to which group your child should be in will be determined by the golf staff. At any time during the season if your child needs to move up or down the changes can be made. If you have any questions about the placement of your child, any member of the Professional Staff can assist you. Call the Golf Shop at 235-2091 with any questions you might have. The Professional staff has final word on this decision.

What about Rain?

If it is raining at your assigned clinic time, your clinic will be canceled. If it drizzles on Thursday mornings we will play; RAIN, lightning and thunder causes cancellation. If you are unsure whether or not it is cancelled, feel free to call us in the Golf Shop.

When do I sign up to play?

In order to play on designated play dates, Juniors must sign up in the Golf Shop no later than **Tuesday Noon** of that week, or have signed up after the previous Thursday play date. If you have signed up to play and can't please call the Golf Shop to withdraw your name **by the same deadline**. This helps in pairing and scheduling tee times. When signing your child up, please let us know if you plan on walking with them. This will help to insure each group will have a parent walking with them.

2010 Junior Golf Program
Rules and Regulations

- 🏡 All golfers must register by Tuesday 12:00 pm, to play on Thursday.
- 🏡 All golfers should call the Golf Shop on Wednesday after 3:00 pm for tee times.
- 🏡 All golfers **MUST** be at their assigned tee box **10 minutes before their tee time**.
- 🏡 All golfers must carry their own bag and walk the course.
- 🏡 All golfers must turn in completed scorecards.
- 🏡 All 18 Hole players must keep their own and one other player's scores and turn in signed score cards. Failure to do so eliminates player from next play date.
- 🏡 Children **MUST** have their shirts tucked in at all times. This includes clinics as well as play dates.

Parent Walkers must take the responsibility of :

- Keeping the pace of play ; One practice swing per Shot
- Recording **actual** strokes of each player in group to allow for accurate scores.
- Allow 10 strokes in the fairways; if not pick up and move to the front of the green, where the first putt becomes the 11th stroke.
- Once on the green, 3 putts maximum. If within 6 ft. of hole, player should putt out and not mark the ball. All putts count as one shot, regardless of length.
- Whiffs count as strokes both on fairway and green for all age groups.
- Shots that land in bunkers must be played from there, 3 strokes max.
- A Shot that lands under or around a tree must be played where it lands. If it can't be played from where it lands, player may take a drop within two club lengths no closer to the hole, and add a one stroke penalty to their score for that hole.
- Shots that land in the water require you to drop a ball on the side of the water you hit the shot from, play from there and add a one stroke penalty to their score.
- Shots that land on the cart path **DO NOT** have to be played from there. Player may move the ball off the path, one club length, no closer to the hole with **NO** penalty.

DO NOT GIVE LESSONS ON THE COURSE DURING THURSDAY PLAY.

- Coaching slows play and should only be done on the range or practice green at another time.

- 🏡 **All Juniors must be aware of the environment and conduct themselves accordingly. Any golfer not showing respect to other golfers, parents, volunteers or staff will be asked to leave the course immediately.**
