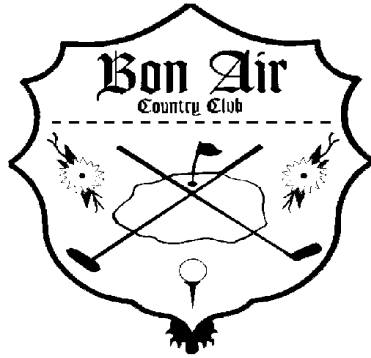

From the President of the Board of Directors... Layton Lyon

Have you been to the club lately? The changes that have taken place over the past two months are incredible! The bunker project is expected to be completed the first week of June. The bunkers on the front nine will be put back in play by the first weekend in June; the back nine will be playable as soon as the sod knits. A fence has been installed along the driveway into the club; not only does this provide needed security for the facility but also sets off the course and is aesthetically pleasing to the eye. The pool is now open and

the sparkling clear water is truly an invitation to take a dip with the recent warm weather. Our Point of Sale system is operational and the transition is now complete; there were several "bumps" along the way with resolution of issue coming to closure. We have also had noteworthy blacktop work performed on numerous cart paths and around the clubhouse. The Snack Bar is now open for the season under contract to Hunt Valley Catering; we have had several dinners presented by Hunt Valley Catering that have been outstanding. I encourage all of you to patronize the Snack Bar, prices are reasonable and the food is great! Monthly "theme" dinners will be offered throughout the season for member enjoyment. As you can see much has been accomplished so far this year!

What has been accomplished has been the result of a dedicated staff at Bon Air, contractors that have delivered a quality product, and a group of members volunteering their time and talent. I particularly want to compliment our Golf Course Architect, Dan Schlegel, for the vision and oversight he has provided with the Bunker Project. Likewise, our contractor on the Bunker Project, Frontier Golf, has done a phenomenal job in rebuilding our bunkers; their approach and commitment to the project speaks for itself. Obviously we would not have the bunkers that now exist if it wasn't for the initiative taken by Bruce Atkinson and Antonio Prezioso to organize a Bunker Committee and get the ball rolling; a huge thank you to Bruce, Antonio, and the other members of the committee! The fence project and blacktop work is a direct result of financial support from the men's golf committee; this support is possible because of the proceeds from our raffles and tournament entry fees. A team of volunteers working with staff from the maintenance department did a great job installing the fence, thank you all.

We at Bon Air are fortunate to have an outstanding venue for quality recreational activities, and we still need to attract additional new members. Our membership has grown, we are currently at 354 members, as a result of the Membership Drive; newspaper advertising has helped spread the word about Bon Air, but word-of-mouth advertising is the most effective. Please continue to tell your friends, neighbors, and associates about your Club; we continue to offer a temporarily reduced entrance fee of \$1,200. It has been a busy spring for the folks in the maintenance department! It has been exciting watching the progress on the Bunker Project and the bunkers on the front nine are now open; I would expect that the bunkers on the back will be open in early July. I want to thank the membership for their patience and understanding while the Bunker Project has progressed....of course I imagine the "free lifts" from the bunkers has also been appreciated over the past two months!

In addition to the bunkers much has been accomplished this spring. Drains were installed under number 13 green, this will allow for significant improvement in the green as the growing season continues. A significant amount of "tree work" has been completed as a result of the donation of labor and equipment by a Bon Air member Al Taylor, owner of Sam's Tree Service. The scope of the work performed by Al and his staff include: clearing trees on holes #5, #11, #12, #15 and ground stumps throughout the course.

We were finally able to get needed black top work completed, which included extension of cart paths on holes #1, #7, #9 and #11; and paving of the area adjacent to the pool and club house. Some upcoming projects include repairing the sink hole in #12 fairway and installation of a drain field in #9 fairway.

A reminder to early golfers on weekends and holidays; ***please*** do not start before 6:00 am. The maintenance staff has significant work to complete in order to prepare the course for the day, and needs the course available so that all tasks that need to be done can be accomplished in a timely manner. If you encounter maintenance staff working around a green or in a fairway do not continue play until they move on; maintenance staff will not stop their work to allow you to play through. Your cooperation, understanding and patience is appreciated.

Cart Rules Summary



- KEEP YOUR CART ON THE CART PATH ON ALL PAR 3 HOLES.
- HANDICAP CARTS MAY DRIVE UP THE BACK OF HOLE #8; NO CLOSER THAN 15 FEET OF THE GREEN.
- PARK CARTS ON THE CART PATH ADJACENT TO ALL GREENS; WALK TO YOUR BALL FROM THE CART PATH.
- CARTS ARE TO BE NO CLOSER TO A GREEN OR BUNKER THAN 30 FEET; 15 FEET FOR DESIGNATED HANDICAP CARTS.
- DO NOT DRIVE CARTS TO THE RIGHT OF HOLES 5, 9, 11, & 12.
- DO NOT DRIVE CARTS TO THE LEFT OF HOLES 4, 6, 13, 15, & 18
- VIOLATORS ARE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION!

BOARD MEETING SUMMARY FROM RECENT MEETINGS IN 2010



- The Board has clarified the Irrigation Assessment Credit, it now includes carts and can be used for 1, 2, or 3 guests for a single use.
- An adult member may now take up to 3 children under 15 years of age in a cart and there is no charge for the children. Only the adult may drive the cart.
- The Board will be evaluating the use of credit cards to pay club fees, this capability can be incorporated into the Point of Sale System.

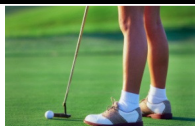

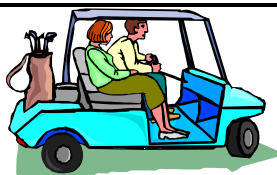
Nine Hole Lady Golfers.....2010 Season

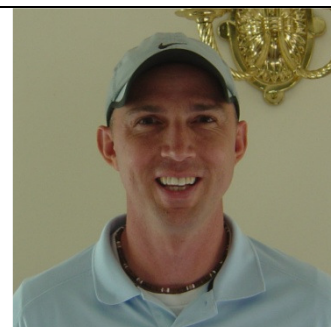

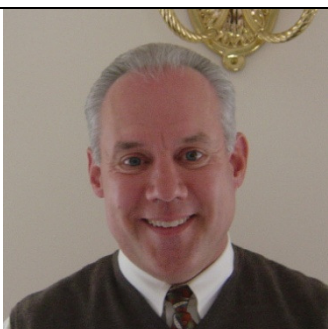

If you play a round you picked up on a couple of holes take your max score on those holes and post. If you were in a match and putts were conceded because it was irrelevant, take what you think you would have gotten on those holes and post. If you play 15 holes and get rained out take the score on the remaining holes based on your handicap and the handicap of the remaining holes. Anywhere you would get a stroke take bogey or where you would not get a stroke take a par. These postings are not optional and you do a disservice to yourself and others you play with if you do not post all of your scores. Swimming Pool News

The pool opened for the 2010 season on May 29th! The pools have again been repainted and seams repaired to reduce water loss.



- Upon entering the pool you are required to sign in for your party and guests. Please be sure that your number and name are legible. If you are unsure of your number please ask the lifeguards for assistance. Remember, all pool members have been issued a new member number!
- The pool hours are 11:00 am until 8:00 pm, weather permitting. When the pool is not being used at 7:00 pm it will be closed. Likewise when the weather is cool and/or rainy the pool will be closed. If you are in doubt concerning whether the pool is open call the GolfShop 717-235-2091 to inquire about the status of the pool.
- For the safety and enjoyment of pool users there is to be no Ball Playing nor throwing of any objects inside the fenced pool area.
- Swimming lessons will begin July 12th; the cost is \$35 per person per class. Classes will be for one week. Details regarding swim lessons are contained on the last page of the NewsLetter. Swim applications will be available on the club's web site www.bonaircc.com or from the lifeguards.
- Pool Parties must be scheduled when there are more than 10 people in the party. Contact Wayne Burgess in the GolfShop or call 717-495-6001. Large pool parties will only be permitted the last few hours of the day to minimize impact on the general membership.
- Please do not go into the club house wearing a bathing suit.
- Remember, the picnic tables outside the fenced area of the pool are for general use, please share with other members.

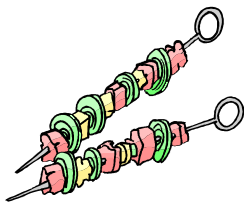

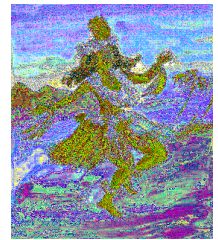
