## General Information

Bon Air Country Club is a private facility with a cap of 375 golfing members and 135 swim social members. There are immediate openings for Golf Memberships. Swim Social Memberships have a waiting list of over 60 families for the 2011 season.

We are located in Glen Rock, Pennsylvania, 20 miles south of York, ten minutes from PA exit 8 of I83; and 40 miles north of Baltimore's Inner Harbor; ten minutes from MD exit 36 of I83. Our facilities include a par 71, 18 hole golf course that measures 6415 yards from the white tees and 6704 from the blue tees. For the ladies we offer a challenging par 73, 5592 yard course. We also have two practice greens and a driving range that allows practice from both mats and turf.

We have limited food and bar service from early Spring through mid October. The menu consists primarily of sandwiches, snacks, and beverages. There are no monthly food or beverage fees.

## Golf

Our PGA Professional is Ryan Paucek, who started at Bon Air in 2006 as the 1<sup>st</sup> Assistant Golf Professional; in 2008 he obtained his Class "A" membership from the PGA and was promoted to Head PGA Professional in March 2009. Prior to coming to Bon Air Ryan was the assistant at Cool Creek, in York, PA. Travis Contres is our 1<sup>st</sup> Assistant Golf Professional. Prior to coming to Bon Air Travis was the assistant at Meadia Heights Golf Club in Lancaster, PA. Travis has extensive teaching experience, especially with junior golfers! Assisting Ryan in the GolfShop are Wayne Burgess and Jeff Thomas. The GolfShop offers a broad selection of golf apparel and equipment. If the item you want is not in stock it can be special ordered. All merchandise is competitively priced! Ryan and Travis also offer private lessons, group lessons, and special clinics to help you improve your game. Additionally, video recorded lessons are available; a great way to improve your game. We also offer junior programs and lessons for youth.

On a regular basis the Men's Golf Committee sponsors a myriad of tournaments with varying formats to attract all skill levels of golfers. We have both a 9 hole and 18 hole ladies group which is always looking for new golfers.

At BACC we do not use tee times. One can either play in one of the "groups" or "just show up".

Group play provides members the opportunity to play golf and not worry about arranging for their own foursome. The following is a list of the various groups and the times during the summer when they play.

In addition to group play there are numerous other opportunities to play golf and enjoy the social atmosphere at Bon Air:

- Golf Professional organized week day events.
- There is a Wednesday Night League for men with food and beverages available afterward.
- We have the Friday Night Couples where golf is played in a more "relaxed" atmosphere (scrambles, alternate shot, better ball, best ball of foursome, etc). Following golf the Friday Night Couples either dine out or dine in with socializing aplenty.
- Twilight Couples have a monthly 9 hole tournament on Sunday afternoons, with a pot luck meal following golf.

## **Swim/Social**

In addition to the golf facilities we offer an outdoor pool. The pool is open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. During the summer our lifeguards offer swim lessons in both group and private sessions. Various social functions are offered throughout the year for the enjoyment of the members.

## **Administration and Fees**

Wayne Burgess is the Business Manager providing oversight of the day-to-day operation of Bon Air.

## **Application Process**

A membership application can be obtained from the web site, contact the club, or contact the membership chairman Fred Brehm 814-525-0889. There is a \$400 non refundable application fee that is submitted with the application and is applied to the initiation fee.

## **Fee Summary**

- There is a \$400 application fee which is applied to the initiation fee.
- There is an entrance fee that has been temporarily reduced to \$1,200; which can be paid over a one year period. This reduction is subject to change based upon BOD action.
- The cost for a family membership is \$2,500 billed quarterly.
- The cost for an individual membership is \$2,120 billed quarterly
- There is an optional range membership: \$125 for an individual or \$175 for a family.
- Handicap fee is \$10.
- There is currently a quarterly irrigation system assessment of \$50; this is billed quarterly and will be assessed through 2013.
- In the spring of 2010 all of our bunkers were rebuilt; there is a quarterly assessment of \$45 through 2014.
