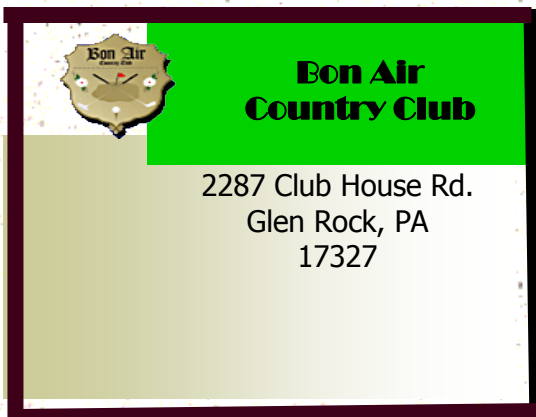

## Reciprocal Club Fees

- **4/23** is the MGC Opening Day Tournament. The format is 5 man team double trouble scramble. Teams are computer picked. Breakfast will be served at 7:45am and a shotgun start at 9am. Beer and soda is included at the bar after the event.
- **5/4** is the MGC Wednesday Night league opener. There will be a shotgun start at 5:45pm. Every Wednesday through 8/31.
- **5/14** will be the MGC New Member Lone Ranger. Please sign up. Any member who has never played in an MGC event is welcome free of charge. 7:45am continental breakfast, 9am shotgun, lunch, beer, and soda in ballroom after. Any playing member is welcome to invite your spouse for the luncheon (new and old). Any member who has joined BACC in the last 5 years and their spouse are welcome to join us for lunch even if they cannot play in the tournament. Teams will be computer picked. We want to make this a special event so please come out and play. Lunch for everyone is on the MGC.
- **5/28** brings the MGC 2-Man Better Ball Tournament. Pick a partner or ask the pro-shop to help you find one! This event will be tee times starting at 9:30am.
- Don't forget to sign up for the Ringer Tournament before June 1<sup>st</sup>! The event takes place June – August. You have to take 6 holes per month but cannot take more. You need to get all 18 over the 3 months. You must submit your card in the pro-shop at the end of your round attested and let them know the hole or holes you want from that round. It is simple and fun. A lot of strategy goes into it and it is a way to compete without taking a whole day for an event. If you have questions ask the pro-shop and they can explain it all. By the way – you get Jr/ Sr Cup points for this event!
- Member – Guest Invitational will be **June 10th & 11th** . It also includes a practice round on June 9<sup>th</sup> for you and your guest at your leisure. If you have not played in this event you are missing out! Members and guests alike have truly enjoyed this event. It is a fun and competitive first class event. We have made some modifications to the Jr/ Sr Cup for 2011. This year will have a fixed age cut at 55. There will be 12 spots for each team (24 players total) and the teams highest points earner will be captain. To qualify to play in the cup is based on number of points earned in a minimum of 4 MGC events. You get points for participation as well as placement. If an event has both a gross and net division prize money will be paid based on gross and net placement but cup points will only be awarded based on net placement.

Don't know what the Jr / Sr Cup is? During the course of the season members playing in MGC events earn points both for attendance and placement. The top 12 points earners below 55 and above 55 get invited to play in Ryder Cup format weekend tournament. It includes team uniforms and a couple of parties. If you like the Ryder Cup or just a good time you will love being part of this event. If you have more questions feel free to contact the pro-shop.

As you may have read in our last newsletter club championship (men's, ladies, and seniors) are all being paid for by the MGC. There is no longer an entry fee and in turn there is no longer prize money. There will be awards in the form of some type of trophy, plaque or medal. There will be no cup points awarded for club championship.

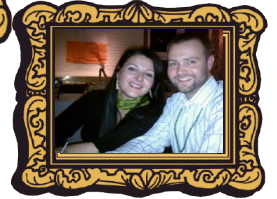
# *Irish Pub Night*

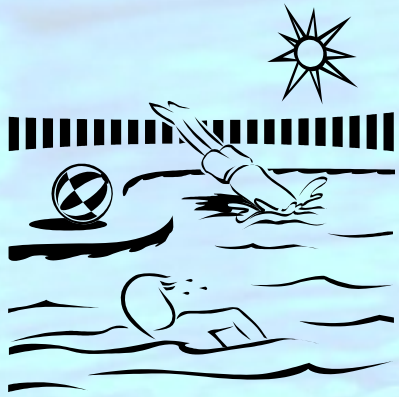

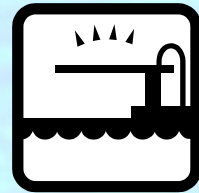

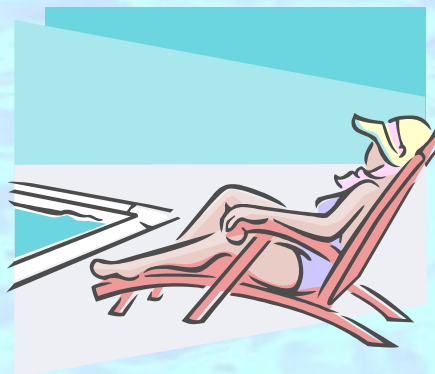




# Pool News...

## **Golf Course Etiquette for Improving Pace of Play**

Please remember, on those days when we have many playing golf and the pace of play may slow a bit, we as members can help keep the pace moving by:

- Allowing faster groups to play through
- When there is a hole open ahead and the group behind you is waiting, wave them through
- If you are out of a hole pick up your ball.
- When you reach the maximum strokes allowed on a hole based upon the USGA Equitable Stroke Control chart pick your ball up.
