Irrigation System - Update

The outcome of the vote to authorize the Board of Directors to borrow \$450,000 for our irrigation system is as follows- Yes 185 No 86. As a result of this vote the Board of Directors voted at our meeting on July 12, 2006 to borrow up to \$450,000 for the irrigation system. The Board is now proceeding to finalize the contractual arrangements. The Board should know within a week the final plans and time line for the construction. As soon as these are finalized the Board will notify the membership.
