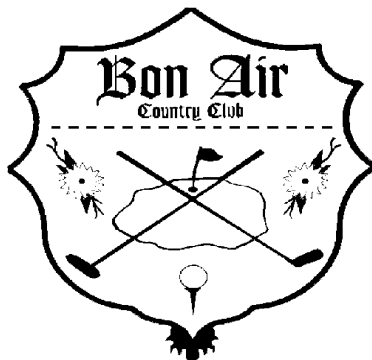

The Irrigation System is now installed and operational, the benefits received will be noticeable as the summer rolls along. Some trivia regarding the irrigation system:

- **There were 595 sprinkler heads installed**
- **Pipe ranging from 2" to 8" diameter totaling 11.5 miles was placed in the ground**
- **Approximately 120 miles of copper wire was installed to operate the sprinkler heads and control the pumps**
- **The swimming pool is filled using the irrigation system**

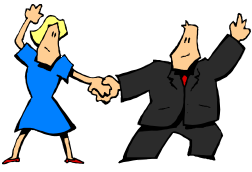

Cart Rules for the Handicapped Golfer

Remember, in order to qualify for handicap privileges with a golf cart you must have a doctors certification justifying the need for handicap privileges. **DO NOT** take a handicap flag unless you have been authorized to do so. For those with handicap flags you must keep your cart on par 3 cart paths except hole #8, where the cart may be driven to the back of the green but no closer than 15 feet of the fringe of the putting surface.

Swimming Pool News

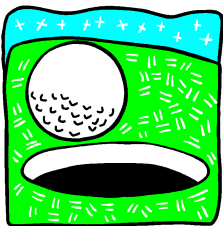


- Upon entering the pool every member (Swim and Golf) is required to sign in for your party and your guests. Please be sure that your number and name are legible.
- The pool hours are 11:00 am until 8:00 pm, weather permitting. When the pool is not being used at 7:00 pm it will be closed. Likewise when the weather is cool and/or rainy the pool will be closed.
- For the safety and enjoyment of pool users there is to be no Ball Playing nor throwing of any objects inside the fenced pool area.
- Pool Parties must be scheduled when there are more than 10 people in the party. Contact Wayne Burgess in the GolfShop or call 235-6271.

BACC Dress Code

- ◆ **Members are responsible for the dress of their guests!**
- ◆ Proper golf attire is required at **all** times and applies to everyone using any of the golf facilities, and includes the driving range and practice putting greens!
- ◆ Men's Dress Code: shirts with collars and sleeves ***with shirt tails tucked into slacks or shorts***, slacks and golf shorts (not more than 4 inches above the knee).
- ◆ Ladies Dress Code: Dresses, shirts, slacks, skirts and golf shorts (not more than 4 inches above the knee).
- ◆ Jeans are not permitted at any time.
- ◆ Shoes must be worn at all times. Golf shoes with soft spikes are required; tennis shoes and soft-shoes are permitted.



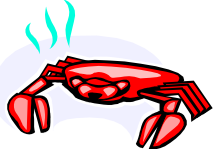
