Re: LPGA Tournament Volunteers

Once again the LPGA Championship is scheduled at Bulle Rock in Aberdeen, Maryland for June 5-June 11, 2006. There will be a Pro-AM Tournament on June 5th and 6th and a practice day on June 7th. The tournament rounds are Thursday June 8th thru Sunday June 11th.

Bon Air Country Club has been selected to marshal the 10th hole for the 2006 LPGA Championship. This is a great hole to marshal. It is a starting hole for Thursday and Friday. Several of our members can recall the enjoyment we had in marshaling the 10th hole of the 2005 LPGA Championship.

Shifts will generally last between five and six hours, you should plan on volunteering at least one shift during the Pro-Am/Practice rounds.

In exchange for your efforts, you will receive a volunteer package consisting of a Championship shirt (Cutter & Buck), hat, weeklong admission, preferred parking pass, food, and beverage chits for the days you work, and four Good-Any-Day tickets to give away. The cost of the volunteer package is \$50 to \$55 depending on the hat.

If you helped in 2005 you already received a notice from the Championship Staff about volunteering for 2006. Please complete your application and return directly to the Championship Staff. Also, please let me know that you will be a volunteer in 2006.

If you were not a volunteer in 2005 and are interested in helping this year please contact me and I will get you an application and answer any questions. Volunteers do not have to be members of Bon Air, if you know someone else that would be interested in being a volunteer please have them contact me.

Golf Membership – Update

The membership drive has been a resounding success. We have received 43 membership proposal forms and the interview process is now under way. The membership cap of 375 has been reached. We currently have a waiting list of 10 people who had submitted their application after the cap was reached. We are honoring the \$1,000 initiation fee for those people. The Board of Directors has decided to set the initiation fee at \$2,000 until June 1, 2006, after which it will be increased to \$3,000. A giant thank you to the members that have sponsored new memberships.

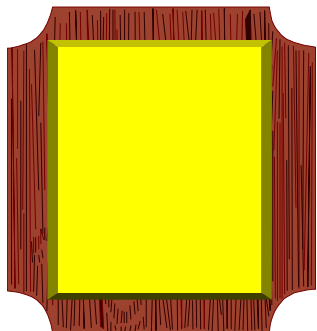

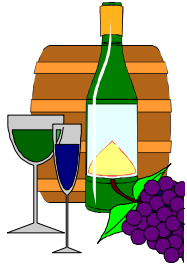
2006 Reciprocal Golf Program
