News From The GolfShop –

The inventory in the GolfShop still offers great selections and special sales are being offered. Stop in and see the great selection. It is not too early to start your Christmas shopping.

Cigarette and Cigar Butts, Sunflower Seeds and other unsightly debris are being left on greens, in bunkers, and in golf carts. Discarding any trash in other than designated receptacles is discourteous and not sanitary, it also creates additional unnecessary work for Bon Air Staff. Please respect your fellow members and help us maintain the beauty of Bon Air and do not litter.

There is no longer a restriction on the number of **Kangaroo type Motorized Pull Carts** allowed. Anyone wishing to use a Kangaroo cart must obtain approval from the Board of Directors and pay an annual fee of \$60. There is also a per use fee of \$2.00.

When driving golf carts please Drive Slow around the Club House. – There are many pedestrians, including children, that are walking around the building. The snack bar area is a particularly congested area during the pool season.

Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied at all times when on the golf course and may play any time on weekdays. Saturday, Sunday, and Holiday play is restricted to **after 5 pm.**

Golf Carts must stay on cart paths on all par 3's. Also, carts are not to be driven behind or to the left of greens on 3, 6, 10, 12, 13, 15, 17, and 18.

Carts should not be driven within 30 feet of greens, tees, and bunkers. Carts with a handicap flag must be kept at least 15 feet from all greens, tees, and bunkers.

To speed play, please remember to play “ready golf”, let faster groups play through, and when a hole has been conceded pick up your ball, do not continue to putt. Remember, a concession may not be declined nor withdrawn (Rule 2.4)

The Swimming Pool will close for the season on Labor Day, September 5th.

- We may have openings for lifeguard positions for the 2006 season. Lifeguards must have a current certification to be considered for employment. Applications are available in the GolfShop.

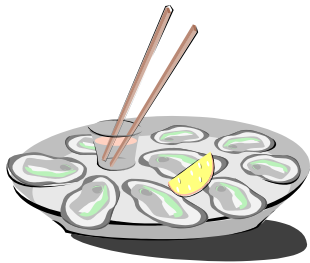
