Ray Lingenfelter appointed to fill vacancy on the Board of Directors

At the October 10, 2006 meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board unanimously approved Ray Lingenfelter to fill the vacant position on the Board. Ray will be serving on the Board in place of Will Kirkpatrick. His term will be through February 2008. Ray has been a member of Bon Air since May of 1990. During this period of time he has been an active participant in golf, social, and committee activities. He has either chaired or served as a member of the Men's Golf Committee for twelve years. The committee has been instrumental in helping to finance numerous club projects and provided the membership with a variety of well-organized golf tournaments. At the request of the Board of Directors in 2003, Ray chaired the head golf professional search committee that resulted in bringing Mark Wiley to Bon Air.

Along with his experiences at Bon Air, Ray has over 34 years in education having served as a teacher and educational administrator. The past twenty-four years of this time has been spent in the Southern York County School District as a principal and most recently, Director of Curriculum and Instruction. His responsibilities entail program development and implementation, recruitment, and staff development.

As a member of the Board, his goal will be to provide leadership that will continue to enhance Bon Air's reputation of providing a challenging golf experience in a beautiful and friendly environment.

From your Course Superintendent...Butch Howard



As we said last month "let the digging begin" and surely we have begun. Work is under way on the front nine with several holes nearly completed. The process involves laying out the location of the irrigation system on a hole including pipe, sprinkler heads and control boxes; trenching is then performed with the pipe installed and wire laid in the trench for the controls. The trenches are back filled and then seeded. This is an exciting period and the benefits will be realized in 2007. We continue to ask for your patience as work progresses and also ask for continued courtesy to ensure the safety of the staff. Occasionally, a hole may be closed to

allow work to proceed, the GolfShop staff will advise you regarding any closures.

In addition to a new irrigation system work has started in rebuilding the green for hole #10. We are now using "old" green #10 until the rebuilt #10 is ready for use. To make you more aware of the scope of work in rebuilding #10 green, I would like share the following: "Currently, the green consists of slopes between 3.5% and 6%. The new green complex will be built with proper slopes and will be completely regraded. The drainage patterns, bunker locations and size of the green will all be adjusted during the work."

The projected time line for the project is:

- Week of October 16th - Work will commence with sod being removed and excavation under way.
- Week of October 23rd - Drainage and bunker work
- Week of October 30th - Greensmix and final shaping
- Week of November 6th - Placement of sod on the disturbed areas
- Green will be covered throughout the late fall and winter to facilitate growth
- May 1, 2007 rebuilt green #10 is scheduled to open for play



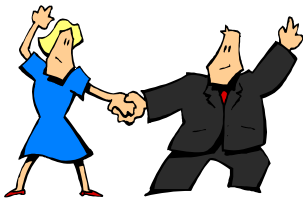
From your PGA Professional...Mark Wiley

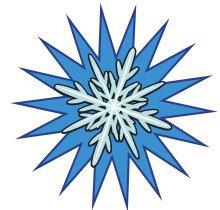
